DIRECTIONS

I-75N to I-575N, continue on Highway 5 when 575 ends. Go through Jasper and Ellijay.

Take left at red light in Blue Ridge (just past Home Depot on left), staying on Hwy 5 till it ends in McCayesville and Copperhill (approx. 10 miles).

At 3 way stop (Michikio's Restaurant), take left onto **Hwy 68** towards Ducktown (approx. 4 miles, stay in right hand lane when it turns into a 4-lane).

Go **East on 64/74** turning right towards Murphy NC. (go approx. 3 1/2 miles, get in the left lane when you see Freddy's Lounge and Grill).

Turn Left on **Golf Course Rd** (just past Freddy's, if you miss it go to NC and turn around).

WWE Entrance is 9/10 of a mile on the right (careful...narrow and curvy road). The entrance sign has a stone base, wooden sign above with a paw print. Make sharp right at outpost.

THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND DURING CAMPFEST

Upon entering White Water Express's High Adventure Camp & Retreat Center, follow the signs to the SSS check-in area. Unload your camping equipment and select your tent area within our designated area. **NO** spaces will be held without a tent. Please move your car to a designated parking space located near the main office.

Restroom facilities have two shower stalls and two toilets in the ladies and men's rooms. The campground personnel clean the showers and restrooms, however, we ask that everyone pitch-in to maintain these areas throughout the weekend. Please pick up after yourselves and those who may have forgotten.
